DRESS CODE & UNIFORMS

High School (9th - 12th grades) High school students are not required to dress in school uniform but are expected to exercise individual judgment in dressing modestly and appropriately. See handbook.

Students should not wear flip-flops, water or beach shoes, or house shoes.

CHAPEL/DRESS UNIFORM for lower & middle school: (which can also be worn on any other days)

Girl's Dress Uniform: Polo/Blouse with logo: white or light blue

Jumper or skirts: navy or plaid jumper or navy or plaid skirt.

Boy's Dress Uniform: Polo with logo: White or light blue

Pants or shorts: navy pants or navy shorts. Belts are required for grades 5-8, if pants have belt loops.

NON-CHAPEL UNIFORM for lower & middle school:

Girls: navy or khaki bottoms - pants, skirts, shorts

Polo shirts: white, navy, light blue, black (Upper School Only), or burgundy

Boys: Polo shirts: white, navy, light blue, black (Upper School Only) or burgundy

Pants or shorts: navy and khaki. Belts are required for grades 5-8 if pants have belt loops.

PE UNIFORMS T-shirts (with logo) and navy blue gym shorts are required for 6th-12th grade students. They are purchased through the front office. <https://www.christclassicalclt.com/editoruploads/files/2022-23%20Gym%20Uniforms.pdf>

FIELD TRIPS Lower School & Middle School students are required to wear the burgundy CCAC field trip t-shirt unless dress uniform is required.

SPIRIT DRESS

All CCAC students may wear casual apparel on Fridays. Jeans, Pants, Khakis, Capris, and Shorts (hemlines may not be more than 3 inches above the kneecap). CCAC/bobcat logos shirt or sweatshirt (only CCAC hooded sweatshirts may be worn)

AFTER-SCHOOL CARE

Our program hours are from 1 pm to 6 pm. For TK students, we offer care from 1 pm - 3 pm OR 1PM - 6PM. During this time the students engage in rest time, snack, and activities that enhance their classroom learning. Children who participate in our after school program from 3 pm to 6 pm enjoy a snack, time to complete their homework, participate in related educational activities and free play time

1-3 PM: \$85.00 per month or \$765 year

1-6 PM: \$250.00 per month or \$2,250 year

3-6 PM: \$195.00 per month or \$1,755 year

MEDICATION FORMS

Medication forms giving permission to administer over-the-counter medications and emergency medications, including epinephrine auto-injectors, inhalers, and diabetic medication/supplies, are to be turned in to the school office.

STUDENT ATTENDANCE

Students between the ages of 7 and 16, and students younger than 7 who are enrolled in school, are required by law to attend school.

- Lower School students (grades TK-6) not in their classroom by 8:00 are recorded as Tardy;
- Upper School students (grades 7-12) not in their classroom by 7:45 are recorded as Tardy;
- Any student arriving after 11:30 is recorded as Absent;
- Any student departing prior to 11:30 is recorded as Absent;
- A parent must sign in or sign out their child in the main office when a student arrives late or leaves early.

Accumulation of 5 Tardy and/or Checked Out occurrences converts to 1 Absence.

For grades 7-12, teachers may keep separate attendance records for each class. Student grades and credit may be affected by class attendance records.

Please communicate with the front office and your child's teacher.

LOWER SCHOOL (TK - 6th grade) 8:00am / 2:50pm

All students may be dropped off at 7:30am

CARLINE

Enter into the parking lot at the last entrance, drive up past the dumpster, then turn left towards the school to the orange cones.

Carline starts at 7:30am. Please come to the orange cones in front of the school to drop off your child. Allow an adult to open the car door.

Carline starts at 2:50pm. Please do not drive around cars unless told to do so by a staff member.

***DO NOT turn left onto Harrisburg Rd.** If you need to go left, please turn right and go to the roundabout. The fire department has asked us to keep traffic flowing on Shrine Club Rd. We can not block the road in case of an emergency.
